



40 Days for Life Code of Conduct / Instructions

The 40 Days for Life team would like to remind everyone that the prayer vigil campaign is meant to be a peaceful, prayerful witness united in Christian love. With this in mind, please observe the following Code of Conduct:

Safety First - you may walk on the public sidewalk and grassy area between the sidewalk and the street. Do not stand in or block the driveway. Do not park in the parking lot of the facility or walk/stand on this private parking lot.

Respect the Law - 40 Days for Life is designed to work within the law; it is not the place for civil disobedience or violence. Any misconduct from passersby should be met with silence. Please show love and compassion toward abortion facility workers and volunteers.

Sign Usage - Signs will be located on the grassy public area in front of the abortion facility in a designated box. These signs are for on-site use by vigil prayer volunteers. Please use only the signs provided for you by the 40 Days for Life team. Please never leave signs unattended. Our set up and tear down crew will place these supplies at the vigil site each morning and return them to storage in the evening. If you have questions, please call (314) 827-4039.

Sidewalk Counselors - Because abortions can no longer be performed in Missouri, there is no sidewalk counseling in St. Louis. However, we are always in need of trained counselors for active abortion sites in Illinois. For training, contact Coalition Life at (314) 827-4039.

No Political Activity - Please no political activity of any kind.

Children are Welcome - Keep children close and encourage them to pray or play quietly and safely, away from the busy road.

Food - Please refrain from eating during your shift unless medically necessary.

Prayerful Witness - Pray however you like, all we ask is that you REMAIN IN PRAYER for the entirety of your shift.

Parking - Public street parking is available along North Boyle Avenue, adjacent to the vigil site.
